

# BCA Twenty-20 Over Competitions Playing Conditions

## 2023 Pre competition changes: -

Further to the distribution of the BCA Twenty-20 Over Competitions Playing Conditions last month a number of queries have prompted the following changes: -

1. clause V. General sub-clause (a)
  - the following words have been added to the sub-clause: - “..., this is with the exception of the Barbados Youth, and the UWI who have 2 teams”
2. clause V. General sub-clause (f)
  - The clause # “8” is inserted in place of the \* \*, in the 2<sup>nd</sup> sentence of the sub-clause  
This clause now reads: - “f) In order to play in the play-off phase of the Shield or Plate Competition, a Player must have satisfied the requirements of the eligibility chart as per clause (l) below. See also clause 8 of the BCA Special Conditions and Regulations of Play for a full explanation of this chart.”
3. clause V. General sub-clause (g)
  - the word “Cup” has been added to the sub-clause. The clause now reads thus: -  
“Where a player has not played in any matches of the Cup, Shield or Plate Competition prior to the Play-Off phase, that player will be eligible to play in the Play-offs phase for his registered team.”
4. clause 16.10.1 the word “franchise” has been changed to “club”
5. clause 16.11.1 the Reserve days issue has been clarified. The subclause now reads: -  
“Reserve days set aside for the Play-Off rounds of this competition Only.”
6. clause 16.11.3 the words “the higher ranking from the preliminary rounds” are used in lieu of “placed higher in the preliminary rounds”.  
The clause now reads thus: - “If there is no play on the Reserve Day or the match ends in a “No Decision”, tie, or abandoned, the team which has the higher ranking from the preliminary rounds, see clause 18 of the BCA Special Conditions and Match Schedule Document, shall advance to the next round.”
7. Clause 16.11.4 the words “higher net run rate” has been replaced with “higher ranking from the preliminary rounds, see clause 18 of the BCA Special Conditions and Match Schedule Document”.  
The clause now reads “In the event that two teams had placed in the same position in the preliminary rounds, the team with the higher ranking from the preliminary rounds, see clause 18 of the BCA Special Conditions and Match Schedule Document, shall advance to the next round.”
8. Clause 16.11.5.2 has been expanded to clarify the way forward when it is not possible to play the Super Over.  
The clause now reads: - “if conditions do not permit a Super Over within the time available to determine the winner or if the Super Over is tied following the completion of all mechanisms as described in Appendix F then the team which, at the end of the relevant regular Season, finished in the higher position in the Points table (in accordance with clause 16.10 above), and therefore the higher ranking from the preliminary rounds, see clause 18 of the BCA Special Conditions and Match Schedule Document will be deemed the winner of the relevant play-off match.”
9. The Appendices to the playing conditions which contain relevant definitions are attached and are distributed as part of these playing conditions.
